Student Blessing Update:

This past week, I had the joy of inviting two Easton Valley football players to be blessed by our congregation. To some, a football game may seem like just another event on the calendar, but to these young men, it carries a weight only they can feel. My hope was simple: that they would leave knowing they are supported by their faith community and, most importantly, that their worth comes from our Lord, not a scoreboard. I also wanted to encourage them to lean on God for guidance and strength, a lesson that will serve them long after the final whistle.

Many people asked about my son, Aidan, and whether he would invite me to pray with his team or lead a prayer himself. In a picture-perfect world, I would love to hear him say, "Mom, send me a prayer. I want to lead my team with God's love." But Aidan is on his own faith journey, and as a sophomore, he currently wants those moments of prayer for himself. That's okay. As he continues to grow in his relationship with God, that may change and when it does, our congregation will be here to support him. I shared a story of a mom from Pennsylvania who inspired me: during week 1 of her son's football season, he walked to the end zone, got on one knee, and prayed. Alone. By week 2, four more players joined him. Week 3, three more. By week 8, the entire team was on their knees, praying together. The mom captioned the video: "On and off the field, they now know how to really fight battles."

Aidan has grown up knowing the Lord, but for Kinnik, this is just the beginning of his journey with our Lord and Savior. Knowing he has Calvary cheering him on and supporting him as he explores his faith has planted a seed. A seed of encouragement, love, and trust in God that will continue to grow.

If you have youth in your life with big events coming up, please let me know and invite them to church. Our young people need to feel the strength of our support in all areas of life, big or small.
